

Project 'Tutorials'

WHAT?

Your task is to produce a video tutorial for students of your age. You can choose your own topic, however, it should be relevant to the subject English or studying in general. Your tutorial should provide **precise and detailed information** to help students with a certain task/topic (e.g. *How to write a summary*).



In most cases you will need to explain and show (!) how to do something using specific **examples**. Don't just give general information. For example, everybody knows that it is important to use only the most important information for a summary – but how do you decide what is important and what is superfluous? That's where your tutorial comes in!

WHO?

Form groups of up to 3 people. If your project requires more members, please contact me in advance.

WHEN?

There are two phases with different deadlines: planning (a) and production(b)

a) In this phase you should plan and structure your project. It is vital, that you do this thoroughly before you start to shoot your movie. Write an outline for your project (worksheet 'data') in which you give the general information about your project and describe its purpose. **Make sure that you have the technical skills for your ideas. Try it first!** Remember that I will not grade your skills in creating a professional clip, but above all the content and language of your project. **This description will be part of your grade!**

The next step is to write a script (using the worksheet 'script') to plan each shot of your tutorial. Hand in your script before you start making the tutorial itself. This will allow me to give feedback and to correct mistakes if necessary. **The script will also be part of your grade.**

script is June 21, 2016

b) Now that you have planned your project, it's time to actually make the tutorial. This **always** takes longer than expected, so please start early enough. Hand in your tutorial on a USB key. Make sure that you export your tutorial as a movie file. If you just save your project file (e.g. using iMovie), it might not include everything.
